

Spring Kid's Closet Consignment Sale

Hosted by GFWC Oconomowoc Junior Women's Club (OJWC)

What does it mean to be a consignor?

Consigners can bring their children's used clothes, toys, and other items to the Dr. Martin Luther Church, where OJWC will host the consignment sale. As a consigner, you would price all your items, enter the sale information into a web-based sales management system, print sale tags, and tag your items for sale. Item drop-off is held on the Tuesday and Wednesday prior to the sale. Please note that all items will automatically be marked as half-price on the final day of the sale, no exceptions.

All clothing must be hung on hangers for the sale. If you don't have your own hangers, OJWC can provide some for you. Upon registration, you will be provided with dates in which you can pick-up hangers prior to the event at Dr. Martin Luther Church. OJWC can also print tags on your behalf for a fee.

Consigners will receive 50% of all sales of your items. The remaining 50% will be maintained by OJWC and reinvested into the community through our various programs and donations. Learn more about what we do at www.gfwc-ojwc.com.

For consigners that bring in over 50 items, or items totaling more than \$100 in value, you will be given 2 tickets to a pre-sale event. This event is held the Thursday evening prior to the sale (6-8 pm) in which you can shop before the sale opens to the public. These tickets are transferable, so if you are unable to make it, you can pass them on to family or friends.

When entering your sale information into the system, you can indicate if you would like unsold items returned to you or if you would like unsold items to be donated to another local organization after the sale (such as Goodwill Industries or St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store). Pick-up of unsold items at Dr. Martin Luther Church on the Saturday of the sale between 3 PM to 4 PM or they will be donated.

Too busy to consign?

Consider donating your items! We do all the work and you get the tax benefits as if you took your items to Goodwill Industries or St. Vincent de Paul Thrift Store and all the money stays in our community, win/win! If you donate 30 items or items worth \$75 or more, you will get 2 presale tickets.

What do we accept for the sale?

- Clean children's Spring/Summer clothing - Preemie thru size 18 (including swimwear, costumes, pajamas, shoes). All clothing must be in "like new" condition, free of stains, tears, pills, odors, animal hair, etc. Please consider the age of items as well. We reserve the right to remove/set aside any items not deemed sellable to uphold the quality of inventory. Items will be returned if marked not donated. We have a good reputation of reselling quality items.
- Children's toys, books, puzzles, DVDs, & games
- Maternity clothes
- Larger items: bicycles, scooters, toddler riding toys, etc.
- Sports items - baseball pants, cleats, shin pads, bike helmets, etc.
- Infant equipment: strollers, highchairs, swings, bouncy chairs, etc.

What is NOT accepted for the sale?

- Out of season items (No sweaters in the summer sale, no shorts in the winter sale).
- Pre-worn undergarments or socks
- Stuffed animals
- Teething rings/toys (including worn sippy cups, bottles, etc)
- Car seats
- Tiny toys such as free restaurant (“McDonalds”) toys
- Recalled items
- Items with stains, tears, odors, pills, holes, or out of date styles
